## HELP PUSD SCHOOL STAFF MAY BE ABLE TO GIVE

### Homeless Program

If student is approved for the Homeless Program, s/he may qualify for free tutoring. Call the Homeless Liaison at 928-445-5400 x130 for more information.

### Native American Tutoring

If your student is a member of a nationally or state recognized Native American tribe with certification, s/he may qualify for free tutoring. Call the program coordinator at 928-445-5400 x130 for more information.

### Before and After-School Homework Clubs or School-Based Tutoring

Ask the school's front desk staff if homework assistance or tutoring programs are available before or after school. If the school has a homework club, ask if it includes assistance from a teacher or simply study time supervised by a staff member.

### Ask the teacher

If your student is struggling, ask if there is a time to have the student work with a PUSD volunteer for one-on-one assistance during the school day. If the teacher thinks this will help, s/he can request a volunteer through the PUSD Volunteer Office.

### Middle or high school

Ask the guidance counselor assigned to your student for advice. At PHS, National Honor Society students may be able to offer peer homework assistance to your student.
