PRIMARY CARE CLINICS

Description: Provides free primary, preventive, and vision care. Offers check-ups, treatment of acute and chronic illnesses,

prescriptions, medication monitoring, **sports physicals**. Refers to but does not cover the cost of specialty care.

Guardian must be present at appointment.

Cost: Free

Eligibility: School Based Health Clinics: Serves students and their siblings who are uninsured, underinsured, or those insured

with high deductibles. Student or sibling must attend Chino Valley, Humboldt or Prescott Unified School Districts, or

local charter schools.

Mobile Health Clinic: Serves students and their siblings who are uninsured, insured with high deductibles or covered

by AHCCCS or KidsCare. Serves Kirkland, Hillside, Mayer, Paulden, Yarnell and Wilhoit.

How to Apply: Parent can call to schedule an appointment or School Nurse can refer.

Cost: \$25 intake fee. Sliding scale fees for uninsured patients. Also accepts AHCCCS and other insurance.

Eligibility: No restrictions. Insurance is not required.

families who do not otherwise qualify for health care coverage.
