What is Girl Talk?

Girl Talk is a national student-to-student mentoring program that pairs middle school girls with high school girls who serve as mentors. Meetings are held on Wednesdays from 1:15-3:30 p.m. at both Granite Mountain Middle School and Mile High Middle School. During the meetings, the high school "Leader" conducts valuable lessons that address issues middle school girls face every day. Middle school girls are encouraged to share any positive news, concerns or problems they may have. The high schools Leaders, along with an adult Girl Talk advisor, are there to listen and to offer support and guidance when needed. North Star Youth Partnership implemented Girl Talk in Prescott in 2009.

What is expected of a Girl Talk Advisor?

- *Desire to inspire others
- *Be in contact with Girl Talk Coordinator
- *Provide program support at each meeting
- *Compile materials for each lesson
- *Be an encouragement to both high school and middle school girls
- *Commit to 1:15-3:30pm meetings each Wednesday

Benefits of being a Girl Talk Advisor

- *Help middle school & high school girls build self-esteem, develop leadership skills and recognize the value of community service
- *Service learning opportunities
- *Mentoring skills
