The polls will open at 6:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the election is to permit the qualified electors of the District to vote on authorizing the District to adopt a General Maintenance and Operation Budget that includes an amount of up to 8.00% in excess of the District's revenue control limit for the fiscal year 2021/2022 and for six subsequent years (subject to certain reductions provided by statute in years six and seven). In future years the amount of the increase will be as provided by law.

The budget override would be funded in the first year by an estimated tax rate of \$0.20 per \$100 of net assessed valuation.

Any qualified elector is eligible for early voting.
