Family Educational Rights and Privacy

During the school year, the Prescott Unified School District may compile certain *non-confidential* student information for use in the public communications such as, but not limited to: yearbooks, news releases, student directories, school newsletters, and web sites.

According to state and federal law, such information as name, address, telephone number, age, grade, school, diplomas or honors received, picture, and participation in school events are considered non-confidential and can be publicly released without the permission of parents. However, parents do have the right to provide notice to the school that they do not want information released for their child.
